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Er, Cr: YSGG Laser Excision of an Ulcerated Pyogenic Granuloma of the Upper Lip Vermilion in a Child Initially Diagnosed as Hemangioma: A Case Report

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Background: Pyogenic granuloma is a benign reactive vascular lesion frequently encountered in the oral cavity, most commonly on the gingiva. Localization on the vermilion border of the lip is uncommon, particularly in pediatric patients, and may present a diagnostic challenge because of its clinical resemblance to hemangiomas and other vascular lesions.
